### CONFERENCE VENUE

---

Newnham College Cambridge is a beautiful venue 10 minutes walk from the centre of Cambridge and 20 minutes from the railway station. The rooms (single) are spacious and have wash basins and a kettle for tea and coffee. Although there are no en-suite facilities there are plenty of bathrooms available. The meeting rooms are attractive and well equipped. The food is very good.

#### *Extra nights*

Accommodation is available for additional nights at the beginning or end of the conference. The cost is £43 per person per night and breakfast is an extra £7. (Breakfast is not included on Monday morning.)

#### *Non-residential option*

A non-residential option is available (deduct £75). However, we would encourage you to stay in the college in order to get the most out of the conference.

### TRAVEL

---

The best airport for Cambridge is Stansted with regular trains and bus connections - plan for about 1 hour. For travel from Heathrow and Gatwick, plan for 2-3 hours. There are regular trains from London Kings Cross to Cambridge (50 minutes).

### COSTS

---

The Conference Registration fee includes accommodation and all meals from Friday tea until Sunday tea. The Gala Dinner on Saturday includes wine; for Friday evening we are arranging a cash bar. The full cost is £220, but we are offering an **Early Bird discount of £25** to all those who register by 30 June 2010, bringing the cost down to £195.
