THE SUZUKI METHOD

Shinichi Suzuki began developing his education system in the 1930s. He recognized in children's ability to assimilate language an opportunity to enrich them through music, he called his method the "mother tongue method".

Suzuki developed his method for the violin but soon, thanks to the work and collaboration of musicians and teachers from all over the world, the method was developed for many other instruments.

Recently the accordion has been added to this large family thanks to the work of Elena Enrico and the enthusiastic collaboration of famous accordionists and teachers.

TEACHER TRAINING COURSE

The Teacher Training Course is held in accordance with the ESA (European Suzuki Association) training program and in collaboration with the Italian Suzuki Institute. The course, for 2024/2025, provides for training only for the **First level**. The certifications will be issued by the European Suzuki Association.

The training course allows teachers to delve deeper into the Suzuki philosophy, teaching, instrumental practice, repertoire and ethical guidelines in accordance with the principles of the Suzuki Method.

The first level, as well as the other levels, includes approximately 120 hours of lessons including practice, lectures and observations.

At the end of each level there is a final exam through which the teacher acquires a certification recognized by the European Suzuki Association.

The first training course for Suzuki Accordion School will begin with a weekend on 16/17 November 2024 at the Suzuki School in Asti (ITALY). Other dates will be to be defined.
