It included lessons, students 'concerts and teachers' participation. Participants came from various cities of Finland; teacher trainees joined in person and online (e.g., Italy, Spain).</li><li>- ESA Voice Teacher Trainers organized an online informative session for voice teachers interested in the ESA teacher training program.</li><li>- TT Mervi Sipola-Maliniemi conducted a summer workshop and teacher training in Poland. Suzuki Voice teachers from Poland, USA and Ukraine participated.</li><li>- Suzuki Voice TT Katrina Pezzimenti started working with a new accepted Suzuki Voice teacher from Japan. Collaboration with Japanese teachers continues.</li><li>- TT Analía Capponi-Savolainen organized an online event for Suzuki Voice teachers entitled "Times have changed – Teacher Education Seminar" which was conducted by Dr. Merlin Thompson (Canada).
