<p>In April 2024, the 'Terra del Castelmagno' Ecomuseum in Monterosso Grana, in the Extramuseo project, printed 'Il sentiero celtico del Paese senza Tempo' (The Celtic Path of the Timeless Land) written by Saracco Amelia with Celtic music by Maestro Diego Longo for mandolin, guitar and harp. The text is translated into Occitan, English and French and contains illustrations, games and musical riddles.</p> <p>The music pieces alternating with the Celtic legend are intended for Suzuki mandolin students from Level 2 upwards and represent an interesting alternation of rhythms and melodies, where the three instruments alternate in solo and accompaniment parts.</p> <p>The projects 'The Legend of Mondolino' and 'The Celtic Path of the Timeless Land' are used in all Suzuki 'plucked instruments' schools in Italy.</p>
