DEVELOPMENT OF ORGAN IN ESA REGION

The ESA Organ Development Committee has had two meetings during 2024, working with strategies to reach out to organists to interest them to become Suzuki organ teachers and in the long run, how to have more teacher trainers in organ.

Three members of the committee, Camille Haedt-Goussu - France, Robert Öhman – Sweden, and Víctor de San Martín - Spain, are planning to take all 5 levels in the Suzuki Organ Method, in order to become teacher trainers.

INSTRUMENT REPORT 2024 ORGAN

Victor has during 2024 built and started a music school in Suzuki piano, organ, and music therapy, where he also organizes concerts every week where he invites students with all instruments to come and perform. Victor now sits on the board of the organ community in the region and might be elected to the national board. He will eventually take all the levels in the Suzuki organ method.

Camille, who is teaching by the Suzuki method on a music school in Paris, will continue with Level 2 when time is ready.

Robert, who has moved to the north of Sweden during 2024, building up his old parent's home, to live there, will join Camille with level three when she has reached that level.

Due to the disastrous loss of her Organ Training Centre through fire, Gunilla is currently concentrating on rebuilding the centre over the next two years. Consequently, organ teacher training courses may be delayed for the next 2 years.

Gunilla is also teaching children by the Suzuki organ method on the music school where she also is the director. Since the school got money from the Swedish state culture institute for home practise organs, the students on the school are able to borrows organs to have at home to practise on.
