CHARACTERISTICS

Suzuki Piano teacher training course (levels 1 and 2) organised by FEMS and Directed by DANIEL FAJARDO, ESA teacher Trainer

We will be assisted by other Suzuki teacher such as Caroline Fraser, Mary McCarthy, Graham Rix y Marzena Jasinska.

Taught according to the requirements and syllabus of each level of the ESA Teacher Trainer Manual.

The course will be carried out in a hybrid way: face-to-face and online. It will be taught in Spanish.

Occasionally, the collaboration of guest teachers from any Suzuki speciality will be possible, as a complement and enrichment of the training.

The duration of the course is between 100 and 120 hours, depending on the level taken, spread over 10 - 11 months. It is possible to complete the course in two years.

Knowledge of English, familiarity with "Zoom" and a good internet connection are recommended.

ACCESS REQUIREMENTS

To access level 1:

Official Professional Degree or proof of an equivalent musical level.

- · Vídeo audition:
 - A piece from level 5 of the Suzuki repertoire (book
 7).
 - Another movement of any style reflecting taste, character and musical level.
 - Oral presentation explaining motivations.

To access the rest of the levels:

· Certificate awarded by the ESA of the previous level.

EXAM

The examination board of the European Suzuki Association consists of three teacher trainers from different countries **Requirements:**

Attendance at least 90% of the training hours. To be up to date with payment. Recommendation of the teacher trainer. Be up to date with: Required readings; Observation of classes; Personal study of the instrument and submission of written assignments.

Registration exclusively online.

Admission will be on a first-come, first-served basis for those registrations that meet the requirements and the course management's approval of access.

- Level 1: 50€ registration activation fee + 1.625€ enrolment fee + 300€ exam fees = 1.975€.
