

ESA Suzuki Voice Teacher training

Teacher Training (Level 1 - 5)

Each European Suzuki Voice training level consists of 100-120 hours depending on the level and each level is expected to be completed in one to two years. After an initial training period, the teacher-in-training will teach students under supervision.

Suzuki Voice teachers are examined on the following: Public Recital, Teaching (group and individual lessons), Conversation / Oral examination (Suzuki Philosophy, Suzuki Voice Program, Vocal pedagogy) and Playing skills.

Acceptance to the Suzuki Voice Teacher Training

To be accepted as a teacher-in-training, an audition recording (an internet link) and CV in English should be submitted for acceptance. A panel of ESA teacher trainers will evaluate the audition.

Your CV should include Bachelor of Music degree (or equivalent) **in classical voice studies, professional performance experience and teaching experience**. Also include any experience with the Suzuki Method or working with young children.

Please take care of the quality of your audition recording and its sound/image.
