#### CHARACTERISTICS

**Suzuki Cello teacher training course (levels 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5)** organised by FEMS.

**Directed by EULÀLIA SUBIRÀ and REGINA FUENTES**, ESA Teacher Trainers.

We will be assisted by other Suzuki teacher trainers such as **Tessa Oakley, Carey Beth Hockett, Chantal Latil, Anja Maja, Regina Fuentes and Alessandro Andriani**.

Taught according to the requirements and syllabus of each level of the [ESA Teacher Trainer Manual](#).

The course will be carried out in a hybrid way: face-to-face and online. It will be taught in Spanish.

Occasionally, guest lecturers will be invited to complement and enrich the training. The duration of the course is between 100 and 120 hours, depending on the level taken, spread over 10 - 11 months. It is possible to complete the course in two years.

Knowledge of English and a good internet connection are recommended.

#### ACCESS REQUIREMENTS

**To access level 1:**

**Official Professional Degree** or proof of an **equivalent musical level**.

· **Vídeo audition:**

- **First or Third movement** of the **Sonata in G M** by G.B. Sammartini (Suzuki vol. 8)
- **"Élégie" op.24** by G.Fauré or **"Allegro Appassionato"** op. 43 by C. Saint-Saëns (Suzuki vol. 8)
- **Oral presentation** explaining motivations.

**To access the rest of the levels:**

- Certificate awarded by the **ESA** of the **previous level**.

#### EXAM

The examination board of the European Suzuki Association consists of three teacher trainers from different countries

#### Requirements:

Attendance at least 90% of the training hours. To be up to date with payment. Recommendation of the teacher trainer. Be up to date with: Required readings; Observation of classes; Personal study of the instrument and submission of written assignments.

Admission will be on a first-come, first-served basis for those registrations that meet the requirements and the course management's approval of access.
