PURPOSE

The purpose of the Committee is to research the possibilities of SUZUKI™ Teacher Training within a University Curriculum.

The Committee is established due to an interest being expressed by a number of universities in the region of including SUZUKI™ Teacher Training in their curriculum.

OBJECTIVES

- To investigate the level of interest in University SUZUKI™ Teacher Training courses in the region
- To research the possibilities for a University SUZUKI™ Teacher Training course
- To explore the implications of University SUZUKI™ Teacher Training courses on Suzuki
 Teachers and Teacher Trainers in the region
- To develop a model contract between national Suzuki associations and Universities to include all relevant ESA regulations e.g. Syllabus, Exams, Examiners etc -

MEMBERSHIP

- Committee members to be proposed by Country Directors on behalf of national Suzuki associations.
- Committee members to be selected and appointed by the ESA Board
- Number of Committee members 3 to 5
- Selection and appointment process for the Chair to be decided by the Committee members

DELEGATING TASKS AND POWERS

The University Course Committee acts as an advisory body to the ESA Board

ACCOUNTABILITY

The Committee will report to the ESA Board twice a year at the Annual Board meeting in March/April and the Interim Board Meeting in October each year

MEETINGS

The frequency of meetings, who can arrange meetings and the procedures for recording the business of the committee is decided and organised by the Committee members.

REVIEW

The relevance and value of the committee's work and the terms of reference will be reviewed annually at the Board Meeting in April/March.
