<p><u>Gunilla Rönnerberg, ESA:</u></p> <p>During the school year 2020-2021 Gunilla developed the digital interactive organ teaching with piano and organ Suzuki students in the communal music school in Perstorp in Sweden, for which she is a principal. Her students use two cameras and Gunilla uses 3 – 4 cameras, and the digital teaching situation has become very satisfying, very similar to the regular teaching situation.</p> <p>She has also participated in digital Suzuki teacher's conferences in ESA and PPSA and also in Sweden, speaking about the development of the Suzuki organ method, with focus on how to teach relaxation in the playing technique.</p> <p>Publications (2020-2021):</p> <p>Gunilla Rönnerberg has built and published a new website with the Suzuki organ method, where she also publishes lessons with students to inspire how to teach the organ by the Suzuki method. There she also has published the lectures she held in the teacher's conferences in ESA, PPSA, and Sweden.</p> <p>Goals (2021 – 2022):</p> <p>Gunilla Rönnerberg will continue to film more Suzuki organ lessons, with focus on how to teach relaxation in the playing technique.
