



# European Suzuki Association

## Country Membership Application

### GUIDELINES

The Association is required to –

1. Ensure that the Association is established in accordance with European Suzuki Association (ESA) Bylaws (section 2.2)

2. Submit a formal letter of application giving details of the –

- History of the Association
- Names of Committee members

enclosing a copy of the governing documents together with an English translation –

- Constitution, also known as Statutes or Memorandum & Articles of Association (the main governing document of the association)
- Any further sets of rules or bylaws, if they exist for the association

The ESA will then –

1. Check that the Constitution is in accordance with ESA Rules for Membership.

2. Present the Application for Country Membership to the ESA Board of Directors at the next Board Meeting when a vote will be taken on the acceptance of the Association as a Country Member of the ESA.

3. Draw up a Name Agreement Sub-Licence to be signed by the ESA and the new National Suzuki Association which grants the rights to use the Suzuki name.
