Sunday 21 June 2020, World Music Day

This event will demonstrate the great ability of the SUZUKI™ Method to connect people united by a single project and who speak the same SUZUKI™ language.

Teachers and students interested in taking part will need to complete a **Registration Form** via the link and submit it **by Sunday 24 May 2020**.

The lesson will naturally focus on a positive approach that aims to achieve a positive experience and maybe a first contact of friendship that remains until teachers and students can meet at a future workshop or convention.

- **Lessons** should last about **30 minutes**.
- There is no registration fee and no lesson fee.
- Lessons will be allocated on a **first come first served** basis so register early to avoid disappointment
- Teachers will be **matched** with students **according to Level** and your teacher will be **in contact** with you **by Friday 19 June 2020**.
- If you are unable to speak the teacher's language or vice versa, the official language will be English, but it will be necessary to speak only for a few moments since music will be the most important language.
- If possible, it would be good to receive a screenshot of the lesson showing teacher, student and parent with a note of the two countries involved.

Please encourage your colleagues and families to take part and make it possible to connect teachers and students from across Europe, Middle East and Africa for a special lesson on a special day.
